Natural Gas Distribution Rate Increase Requested

On July 15, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an application for authority to increase the Company's rates for natural gas service with the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission). The Company is requesting an increase of approximately \$9.4 million annually or an overall increase of 11.1 percent over current rates. If the Company's request is approved as filed, a residential customer's monthly bill would increase on an average about \$8.70 per month.

The primary reason for the increase is increased investments in system upgrades and pipeline replacement projects, enhancing the reliability, safety and integrity of the natural gas system as well as increased costs to operate and maintain that system. The Commission has up to nine months to issue a decision on the proposed increase.

Montana-Dakota has also requested an interim increase in revenues of \$8.0 million annually or an overall increase of 10.2 percent. The Company's interim rate of 28.857 percent would be applicable to the amounts billed under the Basic Service Charge and Distribution Charge of each rate schedule. The interim increase, if approved, would allow the Company to implement an interim rate while the Commission considers the Company's application to change rates. The interim rate increase is subject to refund upon final approval in this case. An average residential customer's bill would increase by about \$5.20 per month under the interim rate.
