Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. Annual Update to the Transmission Cost Adjustment

Effective December 1, 2024

On November 5, 2024, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) filed an updated application with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission) to update its Transmission Cost Adjustment (TCA) rates in accordance with the Company's Transmission Cost Adjustment Rate 59 tariff that states the rates will be revised annually to reflect the current level of costs to be recovered.

The proposed TCA rates include North Dakota's allocation of transmission related net expenses assessed by both the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) and the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) for transmission-related services currently not being recovered through the Company's electric service rates, the inclusion of specified transmission related capital projects, and a projected over-recovery of the deferred TCA balance.

On November 20, 2024, the Commission approved Montana-Dakota rates effective with service rendered on and after December 1, 2024. A typical residential customer using 800 kWh will see a decrease of \$0.95 per month or a decrease of \$11.40 annually. The TCA is shown as a separate line item on your bill.
